Sunday 12th May 2024 World Nurses' Day.

Our team of nurses and healthcare assistants have been busy this May. They have taken **<u>598</u>** blood samples, given 37 immunisations, dressed 182 wounds, administered 65 injections, and taken 57 smear samples. This is just a fraction of what they have achieved in this past month alongside their face to face and telephone reviews and completing their admin within clinics. One of our nurses, Aimee, has also taken on some additional training for travel vaccines and feno testing to assist Gaynor in her respiratory clinics. Unfortunately, there are a high number of DNA's and late cancellations within Gaynor's respiratory clinics which means other patients have to wait a while for future appointments. In light of World Asthma Day on Tuesday 7th May, we kindly ask that patients give us plenty of notice to reschedule COPD / asthma reviews and note down their appointments in advance as a reminder. A link to cancel your appointment will be available through the appointment reminder text you receive.
